USACE EM-385-1-1 40 HOUR CERTIFICATE COURSE

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This 40-hour class is designed specifically for contractors, military, and government employees, doing business with the US Navy, NAVFAC, US Army Corps of Engineers and other government agencies that require EM 385 training. AGC San Diego's EM385-1-1 Health & Safety training course easily meets and exceeds the standards for the federal government requirements. This 40-hour, 5-8 hour day course was developed by the staff of experts specifically designed for NAVFAC; Army Corp; Air Force; NASA; and US Coast Guard facilities construction contracts.

Attendees receive an OSHA 30-Hour Construction Safety Card from the OSHA Institute in addition to a Certificate of Completion of a EM 385-1-1 40-hour issued by the AGC San Diego Chapter, Inc. that is valid for 5 years.
