With the passage of AB 1825, all California employers with 50 or more employees are **required by law** to provide two hours of harassment training every two years for their managers and supervisors! Remember too that all supervisors who have been **newly hired or promoted** from within your organization must receive this training within **six (6) months of hire/promotion**.
