

# IS YOUR CONSTRUCTION TEAM IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE NEW GENERAL PERMIT # 2009-0009-DWQ ?

\*\*\* State of California Mandate \*\*\*

EFFECTIVE: September 2, 2011 Individuals developing and revising SWPPPS must obtain certification as a QSD, while individuals implementing best management practices and/or conducting site monitoring, sampling and reporting activities must obtain certification as a QSP.



## QSP - QUALIFIED SWPPP PRACTITIONER TRAINING COURSE (2-DAYS)

In order to become a QSP, you must take an approved QSP Training Course offered by a Trainer of Record (ToR) approved by the California Stormwater Quality Association (CASQA). You must also pass a online QSP Exam and hold one of the following Certifications:

- A Certified Erosion, Sediment and Storm Water Inspector (CESSWI) registered through CESSWI Inc.
- A Certified Inspector of Sediment and Erosion Control registered through Certified Inspector of Sediment and Erosion Control, Inc. (CISEC)

\*\*\* Please note that if you do not already hold a CESSWI or CISEC certification, one may take the QSP training course & exam prior or in the process of obtaining those certifications.

## QSD - QUALIFIED SWPPP DEVELOPER TRAINING COURSE (3-DAYS)

In order to become a QSD, you must take an approved QSD Training Course offered by a Trainer of Record (ToR) approved by the California Stormwater Quality Association (CASQA). You must also pass the online QSD Exam and must hold one of the following Certifications:

- A California registered professional civil engineer
- A California registered professional geologist or engineering geologist
- A California registered landscape architect
- A professional hydrologist registered through the American Institute of Hydrology
- A Certified Professional in Erosion and Sediment Control (CPESC) registered through CPESC Inc.
- A Certified Professional in Storm Water Quality (CPSWQ) registered through CPSWQ Inc.
- A professional in erosion and sediment control registered through the National Institute for Certification in Engineering Technologies (NICET)
