## **Aerial Work Platform Safe Operation Training (Boom/Scissor Lift Certification)**

OSHA COMPLIANT AERIAL LIFT TRAINING Nearly 250,000 crane operators, other industry workers, and non-construction working individuals are at risk of suffering serious injury or death in aerial lift accidents each year. To limit injury and death OSHA has instituted a strict policy dealing with aerial lifts. Therefore, aerial lift training is critical.

Aerial Work Platform (AWP) course is intended to provide training and familiarization in the basic OSHA and ANSI required safety concepts and the procedures to help reduce workplace accidents and provides documentation of training on Boom Lift and Scissor Lift.

The course will include the following:

- Classroom Proficiency
- AWP safe operation
- Pre-shift inspection
- Function test of unit
- Workplace inspection
- Proper unit shutdown
- Hazard recognition and avoidance
- Operator maintenance & legal requirements (29 CFR 1910 & 29 CFR 1926, ANSI A92.5 Boom- Supported Elevating Work Platforms and ANSI A92.6 Self-Propelled Elevating Work Platforms.)
- Minimum Safe Approach Distance (MSAD) from Energized Power Lines



Training: Only trained and authorized persons are allowed to operate an aerial lift.

Retraining: Workers should be retrained if any of the following conditions occur:

- An accident occurs during aerial lift use,
- Workplace hazards involving an aerial lift are discovered, or
- A different type of aerial lift is used. Employers are also required to retrain workers who they observe operating an aerial lift improperly

**Certification:** Upon successful course completion, Operator Hands-on evaluation and a written test, students receive a Wallet Card
