The AGC San Diego Chapter will be offering five (5) full scholarships for the 2025 AGC San Diego Construction Project Management Certificate Program.

All Scholarship Applications must be completed and received by September 6, 2024.

Scholarships will be awarded for the following:

- Three Scholarships designated to an individual employed by an AGC San Diego member company (*in good standing*)
- One Scholarship to be designated to Military Personnel (*active, discharged, or retired*)
- One Scholarship to be designated to San Diego State University J.R. Filanc Construction Engineering and Management Program graduate

Who is eligible to apply?

- Any **individual candidate** looking to continue their education and/or advance their career by demonstrating the desire to provide their current employer with added value.

Requirement: Must be employed by an AGC San Diego member company in good standing.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must have completed high school
- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Must have written consent of his employer to attend the complete 26-week program
- Must be able to complete the 26-week program, which spans over 1 year.

How to Apply

- 1. Complete Application**
- 2. Complete The Essay Questions.** *You will be judged on your answers, so make sure to put some serious thought into them.*
- 3. Provide a Referral Letter from your Employer.** The Referral letter should outline the reasons the employer feels the applicant is a qualified candidate and their understanding of the commitment required to successfully complete the course. The letter will also state why they feel having a certified Project Manager will help them achieve their company goals.

If you submit an application that does not include **all three required documents** outlined above, your application will not be considered.

Selected finalists may be invited to a personal interview with the AGC San Diego Workforce Development Scholarship Selection Committee in September/October.

How Applications Are Judged

Selections will be based on overall worthiness of the applicant by the AGC San Diego Workforce Development Scholarship Selection Committee.

The applicant will be able to demonstrate the following:

- Being a certified Project Manager will change their value and enhance their current employment.
- How this scholarship will allow them to attend a necessary course they would otherwise be unable to afford.
- Communicate their long-term goals and business development strategies.
- Clearly highlight their history and past achievements and successes through a written resume.
- Identify a specific project their employer would have had the opportunity to bid on but were unable to successfully bid due to their size, or/and lack of an unqualified PM.

Notification of the award will be made by **November 1, 2024**.
